1. Before patient treatment:

- Discharge water and air from any dental device connected to the dental water system for 5-6 minutes.
- Ensure that all equipment has been sterilized or adequately disinfected.
- > Put disposable coverings in place where necessary.
- > Place only the appropriate instruments on bracket table.
- > Set out all materials and other essential instruments.
- Update patient's medical history.

2. During patient treatment:

- > Treat all patients as potentially infectious. . Remove all jewelry.
- Wear protective clothing ,masks, protective eyewear and gloves.
- Change gloves immediately if they are torn, cut or punctured.
- > Use rubber dam to isolate where appropriate.
- > Handle sharps carefully and only re-sheath needles using a suitable device.

After patient treatment:

- > Dispose of sharps via the sharps container.
- > Segregate and dispose of clinical waste.
- Clean and disinfect impressions and other dental appliances before sending to laboratory.
- > Protective clothing worn in the surgery should not be worn outside the practice premises.



➤ Wash hands before and after gloving, a new pair of gloves must be used for each patient.
