HSAE 601 – Healthcare Management

- Introduces core concepts and models of healthcare organization management.
- Examines executive leadership roles and strategic decision-making.
- Covers healthcare operations and service delivery management.
- Analyzes the healthcare environment and key stakeholders.
- Links healthcare management to national transformation and Vision 2030 priorities.

HSAE 603 – Health Economics
