


External Transfer
Requirements



External Transfer Requirements

- The applicant must be of Saudi nationality, or have a Saudi mother, or a mother of a Saudi son.
- The transfer must be to the same major the student is currently enrolled in at their current university. The student must have completed at least 18 credit hours in major-specific courses.
- The applicant must have completed at least four semesters in their major at the previous university, with a minimum of 30 credit hours successfully completed.
- Applicants will be accepted based on competition among them, according to available spots.
- An acceptable justification for the transfer request must be provided, along with a proof to support it.
- The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student at a public university within the Kingdom, or at an international university outside the Kingdom that is recognized by the Ministry of Education. Transfers from private or non-profit universities are not accepted, and transfers from diploma programs to bachelor's programs are also not permitted.
- The applicant must not have been dismissed or discontinued from their university for any reason. If it is discovered after acceptance, the transfer will be canceled, and the applicant must provide proof of the reason for the discontinuation.

- The applicant must not have completed more than half (50%) of the graduation requirements at their current university before transferring to King Abdulaziz University.
- Courses with a grade lower than 'Good' (C) or a score below 70 will not be credited for transfer.
- Students transferring from outside the Kingdom must have their transcripts and all official documents attested by the Saudi Embassy in the country of study.
- The applicant must be dedicated to full-time study and provide approval from their employer if they are employed.
- The student is not allowed to receive both the monthly allowance (reward) and a salary if employed.
- External transfer approval will be based on the most recent academic transcript (academic record) obtained from the university the applicant is transferring from. No other academic transcripts will be considered.
- The student's cumulative GPA must not be less than 3 out of 5, or 2.5 out of 4. If using a percentage system, the GPA must be at least 85 out of 100.
- The applicant must fulfill the internal inter-college transfer requirements applicable to the college to which the transfer is being requested at King Abdulaziz University.






Required Documents at the Time of Application


All documents must be uploaded electronically

- Original copy of the applicant's secondary school certificate.
- A recent, clear, and enlarged color copy of the national identity card.
- Original transcript (academic record) signed and certified by your university, containing all the credit hours you have completed up to the present date. Only certified transcripts will be accepted.
- If the applicant has deferred their studies for the last semester, they must provide proof of the deferral.
- For non-Saudi applicants with a Saudi mother, the original birth certificate of the applicant and the national identity card of the mother are required.
- For a non-Saudi female applicant who is the mother of a Saudi child, the original valid residence permit for the applicant, along with the birth certificate and national identity card of her Saudi child, are required.
- A recent color personal photo.






External Transfer
Process Steps



Transfer Process to the University



- Applications must be submitted within the specified period through the External Transfer Portal at transfer.kau.edu.sa using the Unified National Access Portal (Nafath).
- The student must have a mobile number and an email address to register in the External Transfer Portal.
- The system will send the username and password to the applicants email or mobile number.
- If the attachments are unclear or incomplete, the application status on the follow-up page will change to «Not Meeting Requirements.» The relevant staff member will notify you of the missing documents electronically and provide you with an opportunity to make corrections and resubmit.
- The relevant staff member will review the attached documents to ensure their accuracy and clarity, then approve them. The result will be displayed on the follow-up page.
- If you are selected as an external transfer student, your status on the follow-up page will change to «Meeting Requirements.» In this case, you must print the «Review Form».
- After printing the acceptance form, you must visit the university at the specified time and location mentioned in the form, bringing all original documents that were previously uploaded electronically for verification and final approval of the transfer.
- After completing the external transfer process, the student must have the courses they studied at their previous university, as listed in the accepted transcript, accredited and equivalated.







Overview of The Deanship of Students Affairs Services



Overview of Student Affairs Services

A brief overview of what the university offers to students through the Deanship of Student Affairs:



Student Housing

Student housing is available for those coming from outside Jeddah, with affordable fees (for female students only who are admitted to the main campus).



Student Organizations

The university has multiple student clubs, including: the Theater Club, the Heritage Club, the Arts and Hobbies Club, the Arabic Calligraphy Club, the Computer Club, and the Scientific Innovations Club.



Transportation

The university provides free buses between the student housing and the university from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM.



Nutrition

The university has provided equipped restaurants that offer daily meals at affordable prices under the supervision of the Deanship of Student Affairs.



Monthly allowance(Reward)

A monthly reward is granted to male and female students, amounting to #850 for faculties of arts and humanities, and <u></u> 1,000 for faculties of health and sciences.



Excellence Award

A reward of 41,000 is granted to regular students for each of two consecutive academic semesters in which they achieve a GPA of 4.5 or higher, excluding the summer semester. The student must be within the regular study duration and eligible for student rewards in order to receive the award.



Playgrounds, Swimming Pools, and Sports Halls

These facilities can be used under the supervision of specialized trainers.


