Author workflow for fully OA Journals

- APC funding is requested by the Responsible Corresponding Author (RCA) at the time of the manuscript submission, i.e. <u>before editorial</u> <u>assessment and review</u>. Full workflow is available here.
- Author will need to confirm their institutional affiliation(s), which will determine eligibility for institutional funding. The APC funding request will then be sent to the OA administrator for review for approval/rejection.



STEP 1

Visit www.wileyopenresearch.com/ browsejournals and choose one of Wiley's fully open access journals.

STEP 3

Your institution is notified of your request and asked to approve.

STEP 2

During submission*, you will be asked to confirm your institutional affiliations to accompany your manuscript. This information will also be used to determine your eligibility for funding through your institution.



If your APC will be paid by a research funding body, follow the instructions on submission to find and enter their account code.



STEP 4

If your request is approved, you will receive a confirmation email. Your accepted article is then published **open access** under a Creative Commons license on Wiley Online Library.

If your request is denied, you will receive an email asking you to pay for your APC. Paid articles are then published open access under a Creative Commons license on Wiley Online Library.

Author Workflow for Hybrid Journals

- APC funding is requested by the Responsible Corresponding Author (RCA) <u>upon acceptance of</u> <u>the article</u> (i.e. after editorial review). Full workflow is available here.
- Author will need to confirm author role, possible research funders and details, confirm their institutional affiliation(s), select OA for their article and sign a <u>Creative Commons license</u> to submit their APC funding request to the OA administrator, who will then review and approve/reject.

Do you want to make your article open access: STEP 4 SELECT OPEN ACCESS When prompted, select "Yes, make my article open access." * Your institution will be notified of your request and asked to approve.

STEP 5

If your request is approved, you will receive a confirmation email.

Your accepted article is then published open access under a Creative Commons license on Wiley Online Library.

If your request is denied, you will receive an email asking you to pay for open access.

Paid articles are then published open access under a Creative Commons license on Wiley Online Library.

- * A hybrid journal is one which accepts articles through a subscription model as well as offering an open access option.
- * Be sure to register for Author Services with the same email address used when submitting your article.
- # if you don't select open access, your manuscript will be published as a subscription (dosed access) article. Once published in Early View or in Issue online your may no longer be able to publish open access through your institution or funder. Check with your institutional or funder contact, as policies vary.
- fif you are unwilling or unable to pay for open access, your article will be published on Wiley Online Library as a subscription article.
